

WordPress Website Designing - 30 Minute Q&A Session

1. Theme Customization Confusion

- Start with a lightweight, customizable theme like Astra or Hello Elementor.
- Use the WordPress Customizer (Appearance > Customize) to edit layout, fonts, and colors.
- Install Elementor or any page builder to design pages visually.
- Use Google Fonts or Typography plugins to control font styling easily.

2. Plugin Overload & Site Breaking

- Install only essential plugins (5-10 max).
- Always check plugin compatibility with your WordPress version.
- Use one plugin for one purpose (e.g., Contact Form 7 for forms).
- Backup your site before installing new plugins.

3. Mobile Responsiveness Issues

- Use a responsive theme or builder (like Elementor).
- Always preview your site in mobile and tablet mode.
- Avoid using fixed-width images or sections.
- Use media queries if writing custom CSS.

4. No Idea How to Add Forms or Payment Integration

- Use Contact Form 7, WPForms, or Forminator to create forms easily.
- Install WooCommerce for payment integration.
- Connect PayPal, Stripe, or Razorpay via WooCommerce extensions.
- Test the form or payment flow before going live.

5. Lack of SEO & Speed Optimization Knowledge

- Install SEO plugins like Yoast or Rank Math.
- Use short, keyword-rich titles and meta descriptions.
- Compress images using plugins like Smush or TinyPNG.
- Use a caching plugin like W3 Total Cache for faster loading.
